Shanghai, China (June 13, 2016) - West Mountain Environmental Corp. (the "Company") (TSX:WMT) announced that the Jiaxing Intermediate Court, in Jiaxing has accepted West Mountain Environmental Technology China Co., Ltd's law suits against a former employee Justin Shen for attempting to steal the its proprietary intellectual properties (patents).

"We are appreciative of the Court's action to hear the cases" said Timothy Mahoney, President and CEO, "protecting our company's intellectual properties from theft is fundamental to protecting our investment in China and in turn protecting shareholder value. We will pursue every legal avenue to stop Mr. Shen from illegally using our technology."

Per direction from its legal counsel, WMT anticipates conclusion of this case within the next 6 months.
